Prospective Applicants to AIMA – AMU PhD Programme may note the following:

- 1. The AIMA- AMU collaborative programme is divided in two phases i.e Phase I: Foundation Phase and Phase II: Research Phase. The Foundation Phase of the Programme is conducted by AIMA and the Research Phase is being conducted by AMU. The entire programme is administered by a Research Committee chaired by Dean of Faculty of Management Studies & Research, AMU.
- 2. The admission to the PhD (Business Administration) Foundation Programme is administered by AIMA-CME at New Delhi, in association with the Faculty of Management Studies & Research, AMU.
- 3. The foundation phase of the programme comprises of two semesters. Semester I comprise Module I & II and semester II comprise Module III & IV.
- 4. Students in PhD Programme are required to maintain a minimum grade point average of B, i.e; 3.00 to pass in each semester and for individual subjects; the minimum passing grade would be C, i.e; 2.00.
- 5. The registration to foundation programme shall be valid for three years from the time of admission after which one has to apply afresh. The minimum duration to complete the foundation phase of the programme would be one year.
- 6. Successful completion of Foundation Phase of the Programme does not necessarily guarantee approval of synopsis during Research Phase of the Programme and subsequent there upon as each process is competitive in nature.
- 7. The total no. of PhD awarded till date is 85 and around 20 are in process of award of the degree.
