Criteria for Evaluation

Governance and Societal responsibilities

- Contribution to society and nation at large.
- Personal values, ethics and corporate integrity in business and expression of these values in public.
- Contribution to the positive evolution of government policy and ability to establish right equilibrium between business and its external environment in today's context of liberalised economy.
- Contribution towards globalisation of Indian economy and industry.

Organizational Performance

- Display of corporate courage and leadership - organization under his stewardship must have displayed exemplary performance and achieved excellence despite challenges.
- Contribution towards evolving appropriate management culture and ethos in Indian context and its institutionalisation thereof.
- Contribution towards development of management profession.
- Vision and support for innovation and new ideas leading to turn around of the organisation.

General

- The organisation must be an entity operating in India and the business must have contributed substantially to the growth and development of the Indian economy.
- Nominations of individuals from their own organisations will be considered.

Criteria for Evaluation

Governance and societal responsibilities

- Awareness of and commitment to nationally important issues.
- Concern for the downtrodden segments of the society.
- Commitment to social responsibility and environmental preservation.
- Capability to influence the business community and general citizens for supporting the cause through voluntary contribution of efforts and finance.

Impact on work force environment

- Managerial and leadership skills which could be imbibed by others in their respective work culture.
- Exceptional caliber in performance and delegation of duties particularly under adverse environment.
- Strong influence on peer group.
- Individual's philosophy, moral values, ethics, integrity and consistency towards work culture.

Innovation and strategic partnerships

- Creating awareness among general public and involving them in the task of actually supervising the work and motivating workers as well as other members of the public while also having a strong influence on peer group.
- Innovativeness in approach, effective service and tangible contribution to social, civic undertakings through personal initiative. Developed and implemented innovative solutions which would help to provide better services' outcomes for individuals, business or the community.
- Developed, managed and sustained strategic partnerships with other government, private sector, volunteer or non-profit organisations that integrate both policy and service delivery.
- Involving the opinion leaders to support the chosen cause of Public Service.

Criteria for Evaluation

Innovation and strategic partnerships

- Sustained strategic leadership and innovation that has altered strategic practice i.e. create an environment for organisational performance improvement, accomplishment of mission and strategic objectives, innovation, performance leadership, and organisational agility.
- Significant impact on strategy practices in industries beyond the home industry.

Leadership

- Should be a distinguished and acknowledged leader and an achiever in his / her own organisation / organisation(s).
- Awards won / Recognition beyond his/her organisation for his / her achievements.
- Should have left footprints in the management profession, management thought and culture.
- Demonstrated efforts to create a workforce that delivers consistently which fosters customer enlargement.
- Upholding high ethical values and behavioural standards though he may be intellectually controversial.

General

- Such a person is likely to be past the normal age of superannuation.
- The organisation must be an entity operating in India.
- Nominations of individuals from their own organisations will be considered.
