Dr. Abad Ahmad has been Professor of Management, Dean Faculty of Management Studies, Director South Campus and Pro-Vice Chancellor at the University of Delhi. He was Executive Director of the Management Development Institute, Gurgaon, and Visiting Professor at the Indiana University, USA, and the University of California, Los Angeles.

A Pioneer in developing Management Education in India, Dr Ahmad designed and launched the first MBA full-time course at the University of Delhi in 1967 that became the model for many Universities in the country. During his Deanship, the Faculty of Management Studies achieved great heights of excellence and continues to remain among the top five management institutions in the country.

A Visionary Educationist, he envisioned and developed the entire South Campus of the University of Delhi, where he started new faculties, departments and courses. He also turned around the Management Development Institute, now rated among the top most management institutions in the country.

A well-known consultant, he has done extensive assignments on Organization Development, transformation and change in leading public and private sector organizations.

An alumnus of the Ivey Business School, Canada, and Harvard and Stanford University Business Schools, Dr Ahmad has devoted his life to develop and improve the quality of management education in India. He was awarded the Ravi Mathai National Fellowship for Life-Time Services to Management Education by the Association of Indian Management Schools.

He has been a member of the CSIR and National Commission on Population which are headed by the Prime Minister, and served on important Committees of the Govt. of India. He has also been on Boards of several leading organizations and IIMs.

Dr. Ahmad is a founder member of the Indian Society of Training and Development, and played a key role in developing the Indian Society of Applied Behavioral Science. He was President of the Association of Indian Management Schools and Chairman of the All India Board of Management Studies. At present he is Chairman of the National Committee of the Aga Khan Foundation (India).

An iconic businesswoman, she has been a guiding force at Thermax, one of India's premier engineering companies in the areas of energy and environment solutions. She chaired the company for eight years between 1996 and 2004 and continues to be a director on its board.

A resilient and visionary CEO, she steered Thermax during the economic slump of the late 1990s and turned it around. As the chairperson, she established a high-performance culture at the company and streamlined it by shedding the non-core activities, rightsizing of operations, reconstituting the board and expanding overseas.

A nominated Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) since 2012, she is a stateswoman who has boldly stood up for human rights, communal harmony and empowerment of the poor.

A committed philanthropist, she has been working to remove the inequity of the Indian educational system. She chairs Thermax Social Initiative Foundation (TSIF) and the Teach For India movement. She leads the joint initiative of TSIF, Municipal Corporations of Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad and Akanksha, another educational NGO, to manage six schools for children from underprivileged backgrounds.

She received the Padma Shri award in 2010 for her outstanding work in the social sector.
