A distinguished management teacher, he started his career at McGill University, Canada in 1969 and from 1975 to 2002, he taught at India's premier business school, Indian Institute of Management, Ahmadabad. He was the L&T Chair Professor of Organizational Behaviour at the institute from 1985 to 1991.

An outstanding administrator and business thinker, he was the Director of IIM Ahmadabad from 1991 to 1996 and served on the boards of many large companies, including Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd., National Thermal Power Corporation and Bank of Baroda. He has also been involved with many important government and private institutions, including the National Renewal Fund and the India Brand Equity Fund. He has advised a large number of organizations as consultant.

An accomplished researcher and author, he has written 15 books and more than 100 academic papers and articles. He is highly regarded for his scholarship in the areas of organizational theory and design, restructuring for excellence, turn around management and administration of the public sector and government organizations. Four of his books have won the Best Management Book of the Year awards and one of his books has been translated into Chinese. He has received many awards for his scholastic achievements.

A litterateur and poet, he has published five volumes of poetry in English and Gujarati, which include his own poems and translations of Gujarati and European poets. He has also translated two award winning volumes of Gujarat short stories into English.
