

Important Notice regarding June 2024 Term-End Examination

Dear Students,

Please be informed that the Term-End Examination for the January-June 2024 Session would be conducted in both the traditional Pen and Paper and Online mode following the Regulatory guidelines.

The students would be given the choice to opt for either the Offline (Pen-Paper mode) or the Online mode to appear for the examination.

The pattern of the Question Paper will remain the same for both the modes of examination.

While the Online examination would be conducted through a state-of-theart portal using the Remote Human and AI based proctoring, the Offline examination would be held on the examination centers across the country.

The Date-Sheet for the examination and A detailed notification regarding the modalities for the Online Examination will be issued soon.

Detailed Information about June 2024 Term-End Examinations

(For AICTE approved PGDM/PGDM Executive/PGDITM Programmes)

The Examination would be conducted on an examination centre chosen by the students from a list of examination centres across the country.

For each subject a 3 Hour duration exam would be conducted as per the Date-Sheet notified by the Examination Dept. well in advance.

Structure of the Term-End Examination:

- The Question Paper would be based on the Subjective Questions and one Case Study
- The Question Paper (total 100 marks) would have four sections viz. A (Multiple Choice Questions) B (Short Answer Type), C (Long Answer Type) and D (Case Study Based).
- Section A will have 20 marks, Section B will have 30 marks and Section C will have 30 marks and Section D will have 20 marks.
- Section A would have 10 multiple choice questions of 2 marks each. Section B will have 5 questions of 10 marks where students can attempt any 3. Section C will have 5 questions of 15 marks where students can attempt any 2. Section D of the question paper would have case study-based questions of 20 marks.
- Questions given in Section A would have multiple answers given where one correct answer should be chosen. Section B and C would be based on the concepts and their applications as per the course curriculum of each subject.
- The case study would deal with the applicability of the concepts and would require understanding the situation for answering the questions based on the case.

How to attempt the June 2024 Term-End Examination:

- As done every time, all the students are required to register for the examination by mentioning the subjects which they want to appear in. This can be done through Student Portal's Fee Payment tab (Select Examination Fee from the drop-down list). The Registration process for the Term-End Examination 2024 would be enabled on the Student Portal from April 5, 2024.
- While completing the Examination Fee Form, students are required to choose the examination centre where he/she wishes to write the exams. The centre can be chosen from the available list of examination centres across the country.
- Student who wishes to write the examination through the Online Mode, need to choose the Centre as "Online Centre"
- The Date-Sheet for the Exam will be issued well in advance. The examinations would be conducted as per the Date-Sheet
- All the registered students would be issued their Hall-Ticket with all the details mentioned in it. In case of any discrepancy, student can approach AIMA for necessary corrections.
- Students who have chosen for Offline Examination Mode should visit the exam centre to appear for the examination, while students who chose Online mode will be given the exam link on their registered email id (Detailed guidelines regarding the online exam will be issued in due course of time.)
- While visiting the Examination-Hall or attempting the exam in Online mode, students are strictly advised to carry their Admit Card/Hall-Ticket along with the AIMA Student ID Card (physical copy in original).
- The student would attempt the examinations as per the instructions and submit the same accordingly.

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
