## **Mr Sunil Kant Munjal**

Chairman, Hero Enterprise & Past President, AIMA

Mr Sunil Kant Munjal is one of the founder promoters of the Hero Group, India's premier automotive manufacturing group that has evolved from being the world's largest bicycle-maker to the largest two-wheeler maker. He is the Chairman of Hero Enterprise, with interests in insurance distribution, steel-making, real estate and corporate training. He has made strategic investments in several areas ranging from e-commerce to hospitality. He also supports start-ups on digital learning, community transportation, healthcare, women empowerment and education. He chairs the board that runs the Doon School and sits on the boards of the IIM Ahmedabad (IIMA), ISB, and SRCC. He has co-founded BML Munjal University (BMU) and is President of the Dayanand Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana. He has also served as President of the CII and AIMA; been a member of Prime Minister's Council on Trade & Industry and was on government taskforces that prepared the ground for India's banking and insurance reforms.

Mr Piyush Pandey is the Chief Creative Officer Worldwide and Executive Chairman India, Ogilvy. Piyush was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award by the Advertising Agencies Association of India in 2010, the Clio Lifetime Achievement Award in 2012, the 'Padma Shri' (Indian National Civilian Award) in 2016 and the Lion of St. Mark, along with his brother Prasoon Pandey at Cannes in June 2018. He published his first book Pandeymonium' on his life and times in advertising. Ogilvy India has been India's Number 1 creative agency for over two decades and Piyush has been named as the Economic Times' Most Influential Person fourteen years in a row. Ogilvy was the first advertising job that he got and that's where he continues to be.

Over a career spanning 37 years, Mohandas Pai has served in the areas of finance, accounting, information technology, human resources, education, corporate governance, social impact innovation, environmental conservation, policy formulation, heritage preservation, philanthropy, and the venture and startup ecosystem. Mohan is currently the Chairman of Aarin Capital, Chairman of Manipal Global Education, Member of the Boards of Havells India and the Institute of Public Enterprises, Member of the Board of Governors of the National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF), Governing Council Member of the Centre for Advanced Financial Research and Learning (CAFRAL) promoted by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Chairman of the Regulatory and Financial Technology Committee of the Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI"), Chairman of the SEBI Primary Markets Advisory Committee ("PMAC"), and Investment Committee Member of 3one4 Capital. Mohan was awarded the Padma Shri award by the President of India in 2015 and the Karnataka Rajyotsava Award in 2008, he was previously a Board Member and the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of Infosys over a span of 17 years. He is a Past President of the All India Management Association (AIMA), and Founder-Trustee of the AkshayaPatra Foundation. Mohan holds a bachelor's degree in commerce as a University Rank Holder from St. Joseph's College of Commerce, Bangalore, a bachelor's degree in law (LLB) from Bangalore University, and is a Fellow Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India as an All-India Rank Holder.

He was all of 6 years old, when Amjad Ali Khan gave his first recital of Sarod. Taught by his father and guru, the great Haafiz Ali Khan of Gwalior, Amjad Ali Khan was born to the illustrious Bangash lineage rooted in the Senia Bangash School of music. He has performed at several international forums to name a few: the WOMAD Festival in Adelaide and New Plymouth, Taranaki in New Zealand, WOMAD Rivermead Festival in UK, Edinburgh Music Festival, World Beat Festival in Brisbane, Summer Arts Festival in Seattle, BBC Proms, International Poets Festival in Rome, Shiraz Festival, UNESCO, Hong Kong Arts Festival, Adelaide Music Festival, 1200 Years celebration of Frankfurt and Schonbrunn in Vienna. In 2014, Amjad Ali Khan and his sons Amaan Ali Bangash and Ayaan Ali Bangash performed at the prestigious Nobel Peace Prize Ceremony in Oslo, Norway. In 2018 they featured in The UN Day Concert 2018. In 2019, Amjad Ali Khan presented his Sarod Concerto with New Jersey Symphony Orchestra conducted by Maestro Xian Zhang.

Ustad Amjad Ali Khan was awarded the Gandhi UNESCO Medal in Paris for his composition Bapukauns. The maestro has also received "Commander of the Order of Arts and letters" by the French Government and the Fukuoka Cultural grand prize in Japan. Two books have been written on him, The World of Amjad Ali Khan and Abba-God's Greatest Gift To Us by his sons, Amaan and Ayaan. Sons, Amaan Ali Bangash and Ayaan Ali Bangash are well known names in the music scene and are the seventh generation of musicians in the family. Amjad Ali Khan's wife Mrs Subhalakshmi Khan has been a great exponent of the Indian classical dance, Bharatnatyam.
