She is also the Chairman of ONGC Group of Companies HPCL, MRPL, OPaL, OVL etc having dominance in E&P sector. In November 2018 she took over the post of Director(HR), ONGC on her presidential appointment, becoming the first ever woman Functional Director of ONGC in its more than 66 years of history. A post graduate in Economics, Dr Mittal holds a doctorate in Corporate Governance & MBA in HRM.
