**Don't panic: A doctor's guide to crisis leadership**

*When covid pandemic broke out, no leader knew how to respond. Panic, confusion, inertia and hysteria marked the early reaction and that did most of the damage. Everyone is wiser three years later, yet the focus on immediate issues is already dimming the lessons of the crisis. Prevention is better than cure and it is vital to vaccinate the business and organization with pre-emptive leadership. In fact, given the high frequency and variety of crises, it is necessary to sustain the crisis leadership mindset.
